Monday, October 8, 2018
Regular Meeting Minutes

- I. **Opening:** Present were Steve Schrock, Sharla Vincent, Rose Mary Berry, Tim Anderson, and Jim Russell. Also present were four members of the public.
 - A. Meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Steve Schrock followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
